LOCATION: Cliff Illig's Farm, southeast of LaCygne, Kansas

ACTIVITIES & SCHEDULE: There will be several different activities this weekend. Some designed for our Mustang Patrol Scouts (Webelos Scouts that have just joined Troop 10 or are about to join.). **Webelos are encouraged to attend even if they haven't formally crossed over or completed the paperwork.** Other activities designed for the rest of the Troop 10 Scouts. We should be returning Sunday at about 10:30am after a Chapel Service.

Mustang Patrol Scouts & Webelos: (Saturday & Sunday)

- Meet at Prairie Star Middle School at 8:00am, Saturday March 1st
- **Depart PSMS at 8:30am SHARP !!!**
- Arrive at Illig's Farm; Set-up Camp
- Work on Scout Skills & early Rank Advancement.
- Work on cooking Skills by preparing a hot lunch. (see below)
- Attend & witness Order of the Arrow Ceremony
- Crackerbarrel Saturday night

All Other Troop 10 Scouts: (Friday, Saturday & Sunday)

- Leave for Illig's Farm as early as possible Friday, February 28th
- Arrive at Illig's Farm; Set up Camp
- OA Members, Practice Ceremony & Construct Campfires
- ALL OA Members; Perform Tapout Ceremony
- Non OA Members; Attend OA Tapout Ceremony
- Crackerbarrel Saturday Evening

Other Possible Activities:

- Fishing in Mr. Illig's well stocked Lakes
 - **Bring fishing gear**
 - May work on Fishing Merit Badge
- Orienteering Course (For Mustang Rank Advancement)
 - **Bring compass**

FOOD/COOKING:

Mustang Patrol Scouts, Webelos & All Adults:

- Adults arriving Friday – eat supper before leaving home
- Mustangs, Webelos & Adults arriving Saturday – eat breakfast before leaving home
- Cook a **HOT** lunch (food & equipment provided by the Troop)
- All other meals provided by the Troop

All Other Troop 10 Scouts:

- Everyone needs to eat before arriving at Camp Friday evening.
- Patrols will plan & cook a **Hot Breakfast Saturday**
- Patrols will plan a **Hot or Cold Lunch Saturday**
- Patrols will plan & cook a **Hot Supper Saturday**
- Patrols will plan & cook a **Hot Breakfast Sunday**

ALL Scouts & Adults:

- Crackerbarrel after the OA Ceremony Saturday Evening

EQUIPMENT NEEDED: (There is no specific Uniform of the day – dress for appropriate weather)

Mustang Patrol Scouts & Webelos: (consult your Scout Handbook for a complete list)

- Cold/Cool weather clothing, extra dry clothing to change into at night
- (socks, sweats, t-shirts, stocking hat, gloves, etc.)
- Sturdy Boots or shoes & extra pair shoes.
- Sleeping Bag – cold weather, Ground Mat
- Mess Kit (bowl, plate, insulated cup, knife, fork, spoon)

(These are not provided by the Troop)

- Rain Gear
- Canteen or water bottle
- Compass
- Tents & ground cloth will be provided by the Troop

(The Troop does not provide tents for Adults)

- **SCOUT HANDBOOK (pen)**
- **CLASS “A” Uniform Shirt for Saturday Night Ceremony**
(Webelos uniform Shirt will be fine)

All Other Troop 10 Scouts:

- Same equipment as above
- Patrol tents & tarps (check to make sure **ALL** parts are present)
- Patrol Cook Boxes (cleaned & stocked)
- Food for all meals
- **OA Members need to bring tribal attire if you have it.**
- **OA Members – Remember to bring your Sash.**
- **CLASS “A” Uniform Shirt for Saturday Night Ceremony if not in tribal attire.**

Call your patrol leader, if he doesn't call you by Wednesday, February 26th. Patrol Quartermasters need to speak to the Troop Quartermaster, Mr. Spies, 913-338-4354, gspies@mrsg.com if they need ANY additional equipment (such as: cooking grates, bricks, tent poles, tent pegs, tarps, tents)

COORDINATING PATROL: The coordinating patrol will be the Dragon Patrol. The Dragon Patrol Scouts and ALL quartermasters are responsible to load the truck on Thursday, February 27th at 6:00pm and unload the troop truck on Sunday morning.

DIRECTIONS: From PSMS take Mission Road north to 135th Street. 135th Street west to 69 Hwy. South. Drive south on US 69 to State Highway 52 about 42 miles; (52 is about 5 miles south of 152 which is the exit for LaCygne – do not turn here) Turn left on Hwy. 52 and drive east towards Butler about 3.4 miles; just after the “Leaving Kansas” sign turn right onto gravel road (Stateline Road) and drive south about 2.1 miles; turn left onto gravel road (if you get to the Marias de Cygne river, you went too far); drive about 0.3 miles east and look for gate on the right (south) side of the road, just past the Illig's lakes; turn right into gate - you are there!
