Starting January 2012, ALL Registered Adults must be FULLY trained for their registered position.

If you are 18-20 years old, you should register as a 'Assistant Scoutmaster'...

The training courses required for this are:

- 1) Youth Protection (expires every two years) (available on-line: <http://www.myscouting.org/> )
  - 2) Assistant Scoutmaster Specific Training (NOT available on-line)
  - 3) Intro to Outdoor Leader Skills (NOT available on-line)

If you are 21 years or older, you should register as a 'Committee Member'...

The training courses required for this are: (all available on-line: <http://www.myscouting.org/> )

- 1) Youth Protection (expires every two years)
- 2) Troop Committee Challenge
