Job Description: Works with all scouts, but most specifically Mustang Scouts, teaching skills for rank advancement and merit badge requirements.

Duties of Instructor:

- Serves as the Assistant Patrol Leader in their Patrol, backing up the Patrol Leader whenever he is unavailable.
- Directly responsible for training Scouts who are not yet First Class in their own Patrol and in their Color Team.
- **Attends a minimum of 10 training sessions with Mustang Scouts**, while also planning and performing a 30 minute training session on a skill of their choice. This training session will be planned and performed under the supervision of their Adult Position Coordinator
- Sets a good example and enthusiastically wears the Scout uniform correctly
- Lives the Scout Oath and Law
- Shows Scout Spirit
- At the end of the leadership period, submits a written report to the Color Team Leader detailing which skills he taught and to whom and when. This written report must also be presented to the Scoutmaster during the Scout's Scoutmaster Conference.

Instructor Required Knowledge and Specific Duties

Each instructor needs to be knowledgeable of all of the above subjects, and the Color Team Leader will review the Instructor's skills prior to the instruction being given.

Requirements: All requirements must be completed to receive FULL leadership credit. Otherwise, only partial credit MAY be given. Visit with your Color Team Leader first, then visit the Leadership Chairman.
